WORKER (FEMALE) / RADIOGRAPHER / JUNIOR LABORATORY TECHNICIAN) ON
CONTRACTUAL BASIS UNDER THE CDMO KANDHAMAL

Application are invited from eligible candidates for the post of Multi Purpose Health Worker (Female) / Junior Radiographer / Junior Laboratory Technician in the prescribed proforma given below for selection and engagement on contractual basis under the administrative control of CDMO Kandhamal. The application for the above posts complete in all respect should reach in the office of the CDMO Kandhamal, Phulbani, Pin – 762001 through Speed Post / Regd. Post only **on or before 25.05.2016 by 5 PM**. The application received after the due date shall not be considered under any circumstances. The candidate has to apply separate application for separate post as specified below.

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NB: Number mentioned in the bracket under vacancy column indicates the post reserved for women candidate. Reservation for Person with Disability & Ex-Service man etc. will be made as per the guideline of GA department and relevant rules.

Reservations:-

Reservation to SC / ST shall be made in accordance with the provision under ORV Act in posts and Services (for SC & ST) ACT 1975 and the Rules made there under. Reservation to SEBC, Sportsman, Ex-Serviceman and Persons with Disability be made in accordance with the provisions made under such Act, Rules Orders, Resolutions or instructions issued in this behalf by the Government from time to time.

Eligible Criteria:-

a) Nationality:

He / She must be citizen of India.

b) Age Limit:

The candidates must have attained the age of 21 years and must not be above the age of 32 years on the date of advertisement of post. The upper age limit shall be relaxed by 5 years in case of women, SC, ST & SEBC candidates and 10 years in case of Person with Disability. All candidates being women shall be allowed relaxation of upper age limit in accordance with provisions of the relevant Rules as may be decided by the Government from time to time. A person who comes under more than one reserved category, shall be eligible for only one benefit of relaxation which shall be considered most beneficial to her. The upper age relaxation in case of the Ex-Servicemen will be given as per rule. Further, the candidates engaged on contractual basis under the Central Plan Scheme, State Plan Scheme and Externally Aided Scheme, who are below the age of 45 years and have completed at least one year of continuous service, shall be allowed to take part in the recruitment process for the filling up the post of above paramedics. The ASHA Karmies working in the health system of the State, who are below the age of 45 years and have completed at least one year of continuous service, shall be allowed to take part in the recruitment process for the filling up the post of MPHWH (F), if they are having minimum qualification for the post of MPHWH (F).

c) Knowledge in Odia:

- i) The candidate must be able to read, write and speak Odia.
- ii) Passed middle school examination with Odia as language subject or
- iii) Passed Matriculation or equivalent examination with Odia as medium of examination in non-language subject or
- iv) Passed in Odia as language subject in the final examination of Class-VII from a school or education institution recognized by the Government of Odisha or the Central Government or
- v) Passed a test in Odia in Middle English School standard conducted by the School and Mass Education Department.

d) Marital Status:

If married, the candidates must not have more than one spouse living except otherwise exempted by Government.

e) **Physical Fitness:**

The candidates must be of good mental and physical health and free from any physical defects likely to make him incapable of discharging of the normal duties in the service.

f) **Minimum Educational Qualification:**

The candidate must have registered his / her name in the concerned Council in the State and have possessed valid registration certificate as on the date of advertisement, the detail in which they have to register his / her name as below:

For the post of MPHWH (F)	Odisha Nursing Council
For the post of Jr. Radiographer	Radiographer Council in the State
For the post of Jr. Laboratory Technician	Laboratory Technician Council in the State

Recruitment Procedure:-

Recruitment to the above posts shall be made by way of Career Assessment of the candidates by the Selection Board in the following manner:

Career Assessment: Total Marks = 100

Name of the Examination	Weightage
a) HSC Examination (excluding 4 th Optional) / Equivalent	20%
b) +2 Examination (excluding 4 th Optional) / Equivalent	30%
c) Required Qualification:-	50%
(i) Health Worker Female training course for the post of MPHWH (F)	
(ii) Diploma in Radiographer Examination for the post of Jr. Radiographer	
(iii) Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology for the post of Jr. Laboratory Technician	

- i) The candidates engaged on contractual basis under the Central Plan Scheme, State Plan Scheme and Externally Aided Scheme shall be allowed to 1% extra mark of the total marks of examination for each completed year of continuous service subject to maximum of 15%, which will be added to the marks secured by them for deciding the merit position.
- ii) Similarly, the ASHA Karmies with minimum qualification for the post shall be allowed to 1% extra mark of the total marks of examination for each completed year of continuous service subject to maximum of 15%, which will be added to the marks secured by them for deciding the merit position for the post of MPHWH (F) only.
- iii) Also, the paramedic staffs presently working under NHM out of 10,301 created posts will have to compete in this recruitment procedure, if otherwise eligible and they will be given advantage as per the guideline i.e. 1% weightage for each completed year of service.
