Applications in the prescribed format are invited from the intending candidates for engagement as Sikhya Sahayak in the schools functioning under ST & SC Development Department of Nabarangpur District against the **backlog vacancies** which remained unfilled due to non-availability of candidates after issue of advertisement vide Notification No: 2897 Dt. 29.12.2015. The engagement is purely on contractual basis with consolidated remuneration of Rs.74200/-(Rupees Seven thousands four hundred) only per month or as decided by Govt. from time to time. A candidate from any Revenue District of the State of Odisha can apply for the post subject to condition that, he /she shall apply in respect of only one Revenue District. The application should reach the office of the District Welfare Office, Nabarangpur on or before **07.10.2016 up to 5.00 PM by Speed Post/ Regd. Post only and no application by hand will be accepted.** The cover containing the application and other documents should be superscribed as "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF SIKHYA SAHAYAK INDICATING THE CATEGORY" on the top of the cover. The applications received beyond the date will not be considered and incomplete applications will be rejected. 8. No Objection Certificate issued by Employer in case of in service candidate.
9. Undertaking to acquire Training qualification within stipulated period in case of Untrained candidate.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. (a) Educational Qualification:

Category of S.S.	Required Qualification.
BSC BED / BA BED Language	Graduation with 50% marks and 1 year Bachelor in Education(BEd) OR Graduation with 50% marks and 1 year BED(Special Education) OR Higher Secondary (+2 or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year BA Ed/BSc Ed. AND Pass in Odisha Teacher Eligibility Test (OTET Category-II) Candidate must have Odia as MIL up to Class:X.

1. Provided that, relaxation of 5% in minimum qualifying marks in Higher Secondary (+2) or in graduation level, as the case may be shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to ST, SC, OBC/SEBC Category.
2. Provided that, if trained candidates having the above percentage of marks in graduation level are not available and posts remained unfilled, trained candidates having the minimum percentage of marks prescribed at the time of admission in teacher education courses with OTET pass shall also be considered for engagement.
3. The candidates having requisite academic qualification without training qualification with OTET pass may be considered for engagement only on the basis of qualification so relaxed by the Central Government with the stipulation that, such untrained candidates will acquire training qualification within the stipulated date given by the Central Government.
4. The Untrained candidates selected as per the relaxed standard shall have to furnish an affidavit at the time of engagement to the effect that, they shall acquire the required training qualification within the stipulated period in accordance with the provision of the Act or as decided by the Govt. of India from time to time. Candidates unable to acquire the training qualification within the stipulated period shall be disengaged automatically.
5. The engagement of all Sikhya Sahayaks(SSs) will be made by the Collector under each category i.e. Trained Graduate Science, Trained Graduate Arts(Language) under the programme of Sarba Sikhya Abhiyan (SSA) and for implementation of the said Act. TGT Science will mean TGT(Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics) or TGT (CBZ/Life Science). TGT Language will mean TGT Arts having Odia or English as one of the optional subjects in degree level.
6. Candidates who are in employment shall furnish the copy of the No objection certificate issued by the employer.

(b) **AGE:**

Candidates shall not be below 18 years and above 35 years of age as on 01.01.2016. In case of SC/ST/Women/Ex-Servicemen & SEBC Candidates the upper age limit may be relaxed by 5(Five) years and in case of PH candidate the upper age limit may be relaxed by 10 years.

7. **Selection Procedure:**

- a. The Sikhya Sahayak will be engaged by the Selection Committee to be headed by the Collector, P.A., ITDA, C.I. of School (SSD), D.I. of School(SSD), District Welfare Officer, District Employment Officer and the District Project Co-coordinator(SSA). The District Welfare Officer will act as convener of the Committee who shall prepare the draft selection list and place the same before the Collector for approval. The draft selection list will be put up in the notice board inviting objections if any. After 15 days from the date of such publication and after considering the claims and objections if any, the final selection list will be notified.
- b. **Selection shall be made only on merit i.e on the basis of percentage of marks as noted below.**
 - i. The marks secured in 4th optional or extra optional subject in HSC examination / Higher Secondary (+2) Examination is to be deducted from the total marks for arriving at the effective percentage of marks.
 - ii. In case of compartmental examination the fail marks secured in the subject(s) is to be deducted from the total marks and pass marks of the compartmental examination shall be added to the total marks for arriving at the effective percentage of marks.
 - iii. In case of candidates having qualification of graduation with BEd the percentage of marks secured by the candidates in HSC examination + percentage of marks secured by the candidates in pass/ Hons subject + percentage of marks secured in the BEd/Special BEd examination shall be considered.
 - iv. In case of untrained graduate candidates, percentage of marks secured in HSC examination + percentage of marks secured in pass/Honours subjects shall be considered.
