ADVERTISEMENT

Applications in prescribed form are invited from intending candidates for filling up the following categories of posts in the High Schools /Girls' High Schools under ST&SC Development Department of Nabarangpur District on Contractual Basis. In selecting the candidates for the following posts mentioned against serial number 01 to 08, first preference shall be given to the eligible candidates from Nabarangpur district. In case of non-availability of suitable candidates from Nabarangpur District, applications of the candidates from other Districts will be considered. But the posts of "Junior Clerk" and Peon are meant for the candidates belonging to Nabarangpur District only.

General eligibility:

- He/She must be a citizen of India.
- He/She must be able to speak, read and write Oriya and must have passed the high School Certificate Examination or equivalent with Oriya as principal subject or passed Oriya test equivalent to M.E School standard conducted by the Education Department of Orissa.
- Candidates having Bachelor Degree in Arts / Commerce / Science with Bachelor Degree in Education from any University of the State or its equivalency are eligible. Regarding Universities / Institutions of outside State, the candidates shall only be eligible for engagement after verification of genuineness of their educational / training qualification from concerned University / Institution form which they have obtained the Degree.
- Such outside University / Institution pass out candidates shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency and NCTE recognition in support of their qualification at the time of verification failing which their case will not be entertained.
- He/She must not have more than one spouse living.

1. Age:

He / She must be below 32 Yrs. and above 21 Yrs. of age as on 01.01.2018 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 05 Years in case of candidates belong to the ST,SC,SEBC & Woman candidates. Age shall be relaxed for Ex-Service man as per Odisha Ex-Service Man Rule,1989. In case of PH candidate the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years.

2. Academic and Professional Qualification:

(a) **BA.BEd. Teacher-** He / She must have obtained bachelor degree in Arts/ Commerce (with two school subjects) from a recognised university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) along with a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised university.

(b) **BSc.BEd. Teacher-** He / She must have obtained bachelor degree in Science (CBZ/PCM) (with two school subjects) from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

(c) **Sanskrit Teacher** – Bachelor Degree with Sanskrit as one of the elective/ optional/ Honours/Pass subject from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) with Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognised University / Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

OR

Shastri (Sanskrit) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) from recognised University and Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognised University / Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

OR

Acharya (Except Jyotishacharya and Ayurvedacharya) or Sahityacharya with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons. subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and M.A in Sanskrit with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

In case trained candidates are not available, untrained candidates shall be engaged.

(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the time line as prescribed by Govt.)



(d) **Hindi Teacher-** Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University with Hindi as one of the elective subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) or with Rastrabhasa Ratna from Rastrabhasa Prachar Samiti , Wardha or with Sastri from Odisha Rastrabhasa Parisada, Puri or with Snataka (Acquired by June,2005, the date up to which the temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikshya Samiti , Odisha, Cuttack or an equivalent Degree from a recognised institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) **and** Hindi Sikshyan Parangat from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra/ B.H.Ed. (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University/ BEd. in Hindi (a course prescribed by NCTE) from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, an institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Hindi as one of the optional / Hons. subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Hindi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

In case trained candidates are not available, untrained candidates shall be engaged.

(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the time line as prescribed by Govt.)

(e) **PET-** +2or its equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/ PH/ OBC/ SEBC candidates) and CPED/B.P.Ed/M.P.Ed from a recognised Board/ University.

N.B.:

1. **For the post of BA.BEd./BSc.BEd./Sanskrit Teacher/ Hindi Teacher/PET,** the candidates of Nabarangpur district who have qualified OSSTET(ODISHA SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHER'S ELIGIBILITY TEST) will be given first preference during the selection process.
2. If OSSTET qualified candidates of Nabarangpur district are not available, OSSTET qualified candidates from other districts will be given 2nd preference. Even after that if required number of OSSTET candidates are not available, the third preference will be given to non-OSSTET candidates of Nabarangpur district. If required no of non-OSSTET candidates are not available from Nabarangpur district, non-OSSTET candidates from other district will be considered. In the event of non-OSSTET candidates getting selected as teachers, they have to pass OSSTET conducted by BSE, Odisha within the prescribed timeline. Such non-OSSTET qualified candidates who would be selected as teachers have to submit AFIDAVIT to the effect that, they will qualify OSSTET within three years.
3. If OSSTET qualified and non-qualified candidates of Nabarangpur district are not available, then application of other district candidates will be considered.
